- RED EGGS FOR PASCHA! There is a sign up sheet to donate red eggs which will be given out at the end of the Paschal Liturgy. Please purchase Greek Red Dye in the Bookstore or dye them with onion skins. Please sign up for each dozen you commit to bring. Bring eggs beginning Holy Thursday night and put them in the refrigerator next to the stove. They must be at church no later than 11:15pm on Holy Saturday Night.

Grant me to see my own transgressions and not to judge my brother; for blessed art Thou unto ages of ages. Amen (full prostration).

O God, cleanse me a sinner and have mercy on me (12 times, bowing each time). (Then repeat the entire prayer as a whole with one full prostration at the end.)
